# Change of circumstances and where to get help

It is very important that you notify government offices if your personal circumstances change. Important changes you need to notify include:

- If you change your **address**.
- If you stop or start **work**, or your family's **income** changes.
- If there are changes in your **family**, for example if you have a **child**.

Government offices do not always share information between them. It is **your responsibility** to notify all the relevant government agencies if there are changes in your circumstances. We recommend that you notify government offices in **writing** and save the proof of your notification: save the email you sent or ask them to stamp or write confirmation that they received your letter.

Here is a table to help you identify what government office you need to contact. If you are not sure who to contact or how to do it, please **ask for help** to the organisations listed.
